About the Course: A2 - Elementary



Through engaging lessons and interactive exercises, students will build confidence and proficiency in speaking, listening, reading and writing. The course aims to create a supportive and enjoyable learning environment, encouraging students to practice and apply their new skills in real-life situations. So, we welcome you to join this course if you are 11 or 12 years old.

All sessions will be delivered ONLINE via ZOOM. A mixture of LIVE and RECORDED lessons will be accessible to our students 24*7 to be followed at any convenient time.

Learning Hours

There will be a maximum of 90 minutes of LIVE interaction with the course instructor weekly. There will be 2 - 3 RECORDED lessons per week uploaded to the online learning platform. Altogether, our students will receive 150 minutes of learning time weekly.



Goals

Foster a Positive Attitude:

- To create a fun and encouraging environment where children develop a positive association with learning English.
- To build confidence in their ability to communicate in English.

Develop Basic Communication Skills:

- To introduce and develop basic listening and speaking skills.
- To build a foundation for future English language learning.

Introduce Foundational Vocabulary:

• To introduce and familiarize children with basic English vocabulary related to everyday life.

Objectives

Listening:

At this level, the goal is to understand clear, slow, and simple speech on familiar topics. Here are some objectives:

- **Understanding basic information:** You will be able to identify the main topic and some key details in short, clear, and simple conversations related to everyday life (e.g., greetings, introductions, talking about family, hobbies).
- **Following simple instructions:** You will be able to understand and follow short, simple instructions and directions (e.g., in the classroom, for a simple task).
- Recognising familiar words and phrases: You will be able to recognize familiar
 words and phrases when people speak slowly and clearly about themselves, their
 family, and immediate surroundings.
- **Understanding simple announcements:** You will be able to grasp the main point of short, clear, and simple public announcements (e.g., at a train station, in a shop).
- Identifying the speaker's intention: In very short and simple exchanges, you will begin to understand the speaker's intention (e.g., asking for something, offering help).

Speaking:

The focus here is on communicating in simple and routine tasks with direct exchanges of information.

- Introducing yourself and others: You will be able to introduce yourself and others using basic phrases and answer simple questions about personal details (e.g., name, age, origin).
- Asking and answering simple questions: You will be able to ask and answer simple questions on familiar topics such as family, hobbies, daily routines, and immediate needs.
- **Describing familiar things and people:** You will be able to describe in simple terms aspects of your background, immediate environment, and everyday routines (e.g., your family, your home, what you do every day).
- Making simple requests and offers: You will be able to make simple requests and respond to offers in familiar situations.
- Handling very short social exchanges: You will be able to manage very short, basic social interactions using polite greetings and farewells.
- Expressing basic likes and dislikes: You will be able to express simple preferences and opinions using basic phrases.

Vocabulary:

At this level, vocabulary acquisition focuses on words and phrases related to everyday situations and needs.

- Learning basic personal information vocabulary: You will learn and use vocabulary related to personal details (name, age, nationality), family members, and physical descriptions.
- Understanding and using vocabulary related to daily routines: You will learn words and phrases connected to everyday activities (e.g., eating, sleeping, working, studying).
- Acquiring vocabulary for common objects and places: You will learn the names of common objects around you (e.g., furniture, clothes) and places in your local environment (e.g., home, school, shops).
- Learning vocabulary related to food and drink: You will expand your vocabulary related to common food items and drinks.
- Understanding and using basic time expressions: You will learn and use simple vocabulary related to time (e.g., days of the week, months, times of the day).
- Learning basic adjectives and adverbs: You will learn and use simple adjectives to describe people and things (e.g., happy, big, old) and basic adverbs (e.g., quickly, slowly).

Social and Emotional Objectives:

Language learning isn't just about words and grammar; it also involves developing social and emotional skills to interact effectively and confidently.

- Building confidence in simple interactions: You will aim to feel more confident when participating in basic English conversations.
- **Developing willingness to communicate:** You will be encouraged to actively try to communicate in English, even if you make mistakes.
- Learning to ask for clarification: You will learn simple phrases to ask for repetition or clarification when you don't understand (e.g., "Excuse me?", "Can you repeat that, please?").
- Showing awareness of basic social conventions: You will learn and practice basic English greetings and polite expressions.
- Managing anxiety related to speaking: You will work on strategies to reduce nervousness when speaking English.
- **Developing empathy in communication:** You will begin to understand that communication involves not just the words but also the feelings of the other person.
- Collaborating in simple language tasks: When working with others, you will practice simple ways to cooperate and contribute using English.

Our Learning Platform

Lessons	Each student will be given access to the Online Learning Platform. There will be • recorded sessions • live sessions available depending on the teacher's lesson plan and availability. Lessons will be made available in the online learning platform according to the timetable given below. Each week

Teaching Strategies

Parents' Involvement

- Parents are advised to accompany children during LIVE and RECORDED sessions until they complete the Starter Level.
- Translating the teacher-instructions to the child's mother tongue must be avoided.
- Engage in simple English conversations with their children outside of class to reinforce learning and build confidence.
- Provide a supportive environment at home by showing interest in the child's progress and celebrating their achievements, no matter how small.
- Assist with setting up a consistent study schedule to ensure children have dedicated time for practice and review of the lessons.
- Communicate regularly with the instructor to stay updated on your child's progress and discuss any concerns or areas for improvement.
- Print the relevant study material at the beginning of each month before the new sessions start.

Class Holidays

• LIVE sessions will not be conducted on Poya Days, Sinhala & Tamil New Year, Thai Pongal Day, Ramadan, Hajji Festival and Christmas Day. Recorded sessions will be posted according to the set timetable.

Fee Payment



- Payments are collected on a Term (four-month) or Half Term (Two-month) or Monthly basis. Parents are required to pay the fee on or before the due date to access the course.
